Maths - Musical Instruments

Provide a range of different instruments such as drums, beaters, shakers and encourage your child to play patterns using the instruments. This could be made into a game. Your child could play a pattern whilst the rest of the listeners face the other way. The listeners then try and work out which instruments were used and replicate the pattern.

Refresh Your Rainbow Poster!


Talk about the different windows you have seen on your walks. Have you seen rainbows, teddy bears, or other things that made you smile?

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Maths - Subtraction Splat

First, take some card and write out some subtraction questions using a pen.

Next, use the playdough to make a number of balls for your game.

Ask your child to pick a subtraction card and lay out as many balls as the first number.

For instance, if the sentence was "5-4" you would lay out 5.

Now ask your child to SPLAT as many as the second number with their hand.

Ask your child "How many are remaining?" and recap the number sentence for them in full.



Phonics : Anagrams

Write a Phase 3/4 word on a strip of paper jumbled into an anagram. i.e: w-c-o-l-n (clown). Explain to your child that your word is jumbled up and you need their help to rearrange it into the correct order.

Tell your child what the word should be and then ask them to cut out the individual letters segmenting as they go.

Once they have completed this - ask your child to blend the word together to check they have placed all of the letters in the correct place.



Hold a Photo Session!

If you can, allow your child to use a camera, mobile phone or any other electronic device to take some photos. What will you photograph? Your pets or toys perhaps?


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Maths - 3D Shapes

Show the children a collection of 3D Shapes. Choose one of the shapes. Ask your child to tell you as many things as they can about the shape. Can they find another shape like this? Can they find a different shape? How is it different?



Sort the shapes into groups.

Ask: 'Why did you put these shapes together? How is this set different to this one? Is there another way we could sort them?'

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
Maths
